**(A NGCSU School of Education/CaseNEX Collaborative Program)**  
**Required for All Candidates Seeking Initial Certification**

All students entering the program must have a baccalaureate degree or higher from an accredited institution **before beginning any professional education course work leading to certification.** Each location may close at different times if they reach maximum capacity. Candidates are accepted on a first come first served basis when all requirements are satisfied if space is available. All requirements must be satisfied before submitting an application. *Copies of GACE Basic Skills scores or documentation of exemption scores, copies of GACE Content scores, official transcripts, and the consent form for a criminal background check must be attached to your application. Incomplete applications will not be held, pending receipt of missing information.*

**Important Notes for Program:**

- 1) **The Post- Baccalaureate Program is a Professional Learning Unit (PLU) program that will lead to Initial Certification. The coursework in which you receive PLU credit can not be applied to Graduate degree work.**
- 2) **Depending on the undergraduate degree you received, you may have additional content coursework that is needed to obtain the Initial Certification. This content coursework must be completed before beginning the Post-Baccalaureate Program.**
- 3) **Costs for the Post- Baccalaureate Initial Certification Program is \$7000. This covers all program costs, fees, and books for the Post- Baccalaureate Program excluding additional content if needed. The July Cohort payment schedule is July 15<sup>th</sup> \$2100, September 7<sup>th</sup> \$2800, and November 1<sup>st</sup> \$2100.**
- 4) **Upon completion of the Post-Baccalaureate Program, you will receive PLU Credits from the NGCSU School of Education. Documentation of the completed PLUs will need to be submitted along with the Professional Standards Commission Certification Application to the Certification Official at North Georgia College & State University. The recommendation form will be completed by the Certification Official and forwarded to the Georgia Professional Standards Commission for certification. During the last semester of the program, you will be given detailed information regarding completing the certification process.**

## **POST-BACCALAUREATE PROGRAMS:**

All applicants must have passed or exempted the GACE Basic Skills examination (fee involved). Applicant must have passed the GACE Content examination prior to entering Student Teaching (fee involved). Documentation must be provided to be reviewed for acceptance into the program. Information about GACE registration can be found on the web site of the Georgia Professional Standards Commission: [www.gapsc.com](http://www.gapsc.com).

GACE Basic Skills may be exempted with any of the following sets of scores: SAT—minimum composite of 1000; ACT—minimum composite of 43 (English and Math combined scores); or GRE—minimum composite of 1030; a Masters Degree or above from a PSC-accepted accredited institution. SAT or ACT scores may be verified with high school transcripts. If you took the SAT before April 1995, or the ACT before October 1989, call the Teacher Education Office (706/864-1533) to have your scores recalculated. Some scores may be higher than what appears on the old records.

Submit with the application a copy of your official college transcript.

The minimum GPA requirement for Teacher Education Post-Baccalaureate Programs is 2.5. If admitted to the program with a GPA lower than 2.5, the student must submit a letter of appeal with the Post-Baccalaureate application.

### **Cohort Programs**

Eligibility for admission is based upon the criteria listed above. Students are admitted into the Post-Baccalaureate Program as part of a cohort group based on the evaluation of the Post-Baccalaureate Program Admissions Committee. The cohort group completes the professional education sequential course work together. This provides each group of students with a common set of experiences. It also ensures that students will not encounter schedule conflicts and will take courses in a logical fashion.

All Post-Baccalaureate programs are planned according to the month that the student begins upper division or Post-Baccalaureate professional education course work. This requires the student to remain in sequence with a cohort group in order to complete the professional education program of study within the planned amount of time. The student and advisor must plan and file a program of study during the first semester in the program. If a student fails to take a course, it may be a year before the course is offered again.

Students will be assigned to field placements by the program. They must not attempt to arrange such placements themselves, because in many programs the placements are in partner schools only. Post-Baccalaureate supervision is offered within the NGCSU service area only. Students who are considering positions in remote locations must consult with the field placement office regarding the feasibility of program completion.

Transportation is the responsibility of the student.

### **Program Levels and Degrees**

The Post-Baccalaureate certification cohort in Middle Grades, Secondary and P-12 fields is designed to provide initial certification for people who already hold at least a bachelor's degree in a content field. Students may pursue the master's degree after earning initial certification. **PLU credits earned in the post-baccalaureate certification program will not apply as graduate credit toward master's degree**

Students are accepted to enter a particular program during a particular semester. Changing either the program or the entry date requires reapplication to the program.
