In-State/Out-of-State Classification

At the time of admission to North Georgia College & State University, a student will be classified as either a resident or non-resident of the State of Georgia for determining the amount of tuition a student will be assessed. A student will either be assessed the resident (in-state) or non-resident (out-of-state) tuition rate listed above based on the determination. Policies and procedures for determining the classification of residency status are set forth by the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia.

**On-Line Course Information

On-line courses are not subject to Guaranteed Tuition or regular tuition rates, and are billed at \$300.00 per credit hour.

Tuition for on-line courses may exceed the cap amount for 15 credit hours. Students enrolling in only on-line courses are exempt from mandatory student fees, with the exception of the technology and institution fees - totaling \$300.00.

Mandatory Student Fees

Students are required to pay the mandatory fees listed below, with the exception of graduate students taking less than 6 hours. Graduate students taking less than 6 hours are required to pay the Access Fee, Recreation Center Fee, and Institution Fee, as well as 1/2 the Activity Fee, Athletic Fee, Health Services Fee and Technology Fee. For students enrolled in the MBA and Master of International Affairs programs, the mandatory fees are campus and program specific. (see rates above)
