Students transferring from a non-USG school who have completed at least one course that was acceptable under NGCSU's old Area B may elect to complete the old NGCSU Area B.</p> <p>C. Students initially transferring at least one Area B course completed at a prior USG institution may:</p> <p>Option 1: Complete Area B at the prior USG college via transient permission</p> <p>Option 2: Complete prior USG college Area B requirements at NGCSU</p> <p>Option 3: Request approval from AVPAA to complete requirements of previous NGCSU Area B</p>

<p>Required: 3 hrs HIST 1112</p> <p>Select one: 3 hrs HIST 2111, 2112, or POLS 1101</p> <p>Select one from each grouping: 6 hrs Global Perspectives Group ANTH 1101, ECON 2105, GEOG 1101, HIST 1111, or POLS 2401 Social Science Group HIST 2111, HIST 2112, POLS 1101, PSYC 1101 or SOCI 1101</p>	<p>Not more than 6 hours in one discipline</p>	<p>A. Students transferring in less than 6 hours of Area E courses must complete the new NGCSU Area E requirements.</p> <p>B. Students transferring in 6 or more hours may complete new Area E NGCSU requirements with the following caveats:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must take HIST 1112 • In addition to HIST 1112, six hours of AREA E history courses initially transferred from another university are allowed • 2 transfer courses from one group may be used. <p>OR Request approval from AVPAA to complete requirements of previous NGCSU Area E</p>
