

Cadet Overnight Visitation Experience Packing List, Reporting and Departure Instruction

Note 1: You must inform the Cadet Recruitment Center if you change your mind about attending, or cannot attend for any reason. Please call 888 413-9366.

Note 2: Emergency phone number. If you get delayed, lost, or have an accident en route, or if your family needs to contact you during your overnight visit, please call: 706 864-1420.

Note 3: You must provide your own transportation to and from campus.

Reporting Time and Location

Please arrive at the Pennington Military Leadership Center which is to the left of the main campus entrance, across the street from Dairy Queen. Arrive between 1730 and 1800. Park in the lot in front of the main entrance to the Pennington Military Leadership Center. Go through the front entrance and proceed approximately half way down the atrium. There is an office with a cadet on duty on the left. Report to that cadet and tell him or her that you are there for the Cadet Overnight Visitation Experience.

What to Wear

We request that you wear conservative clothing appropriate to the weather (check the weather forecast for Dahlonega, Georgia before you pack). For men, please wear slacks or blue jeans with no holes; a polo shirt or other dress-type shirt (no T-shirts); a belt; socks; and shoes (tennis shoes are acceptable). Women should wear something equivalent.
